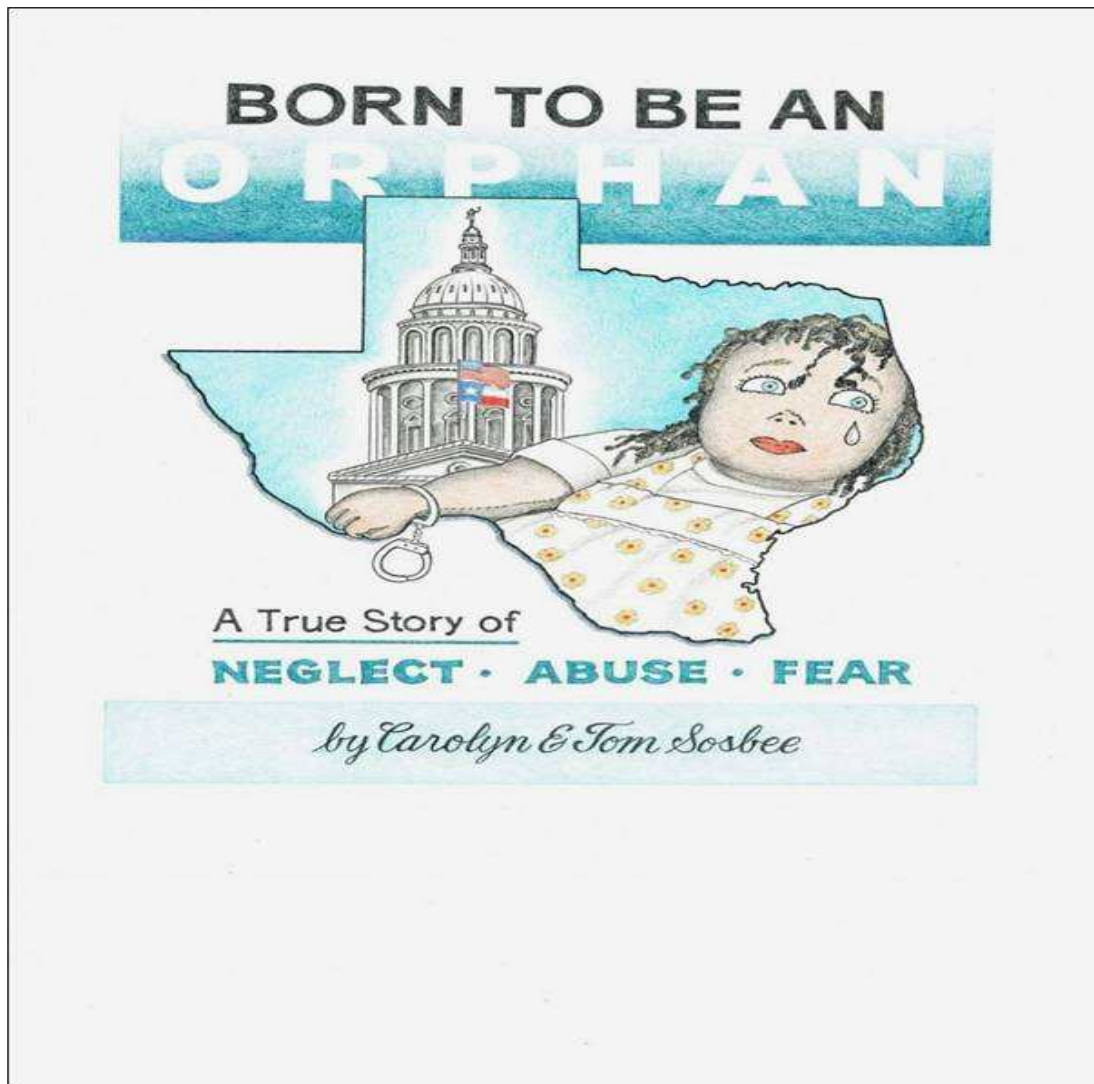


Author Biography

Carolyn Ann MacKenney Sosbee was born in San Antonio, Texas to poverty stricken parents. Through legal system wrangling against her parents; several distant relatives used their money and influence to take Carolyn and her siblings away from their parents. This started Carolyn's journey through the Texas Child Welfare System. She became a "Ward of the State," and during her time spent at Coastal Bend Youth City, she was sexually molested repeatedly by a County Judge, and Youth City Staff; severely physically abused; forced to work in "slave-like" conditions. After 7 years in "Custody," she was kidnapped from Youth City by her adoptive parents, without ever going back to court. The State of Texas has continuously denied that she ever existed, even though she has irrefutable evidence that she was. Carolyn remains a staunch advocate for Texas Orphans; confronting Governor Perry and US Senator John Cornyn regarding her case; and the apparent cover-up of her time spent as a Ward of the State.
